### **CES PTA General Membership Meeting**

Meeting was called to order at 6:30pm by President, Milly Mount.

Pledge led by Reed Gardner with BSA pack #50

Minutes from previous General Membership Meeting posted on website, were voted on, and approved.

Vice President, Ashlee Pillow, provided the inspiration.

Treasurer, Stefanie Gardner, gave the treasurer's report:

- Started month of August with \$60,717.39
- Received \$12,248.59 (mostly membership & corporate donations)
- Expenditures \$6,629.33 (mostly Hall of Fame in school and teacher team building)
- Finished month with \$66,336.65

#### Principal's report given by Mr. Salyer:

- Mr. Salyer thanked families for a great start of the school year.
- Trying something new – Live 4<sup>th</sup> grade performance tonight on Twitter
- Tomorrow – bring \$1 and dress in Disney attire for Go Jim Go, which will take place Thursday.
- October 31<sup>st</sup> – Bring \$1 and dress up in costume; ensure costumes are appropriate.
- State scores are back – CES scored highest possible ranking in TN
- Collierville Independent Reader's Choice award – we ranked best school and best PTA last year. We need help again this year (if you agree) we want Best School, PTA & Teacher awards!
- Dragon Dash coming up – pep rally on Thursday

#### New Business:

Budget Committee has met: Stefanie Gardner reviewed 2018-2019 proposed budget – proposed income \$72,700; proposed expenses \$38,510; Shannon Vanfleet second. Floor open for discussion. No questions. No opposed. All in favor, approved.

Stefanie Gardner discussed 2017-18 Financial Audit – End of fiscal year (6-30-18) books audited by an outside independent auditor, report came back - everything correct. Any questions about audit see Stefanie once meeting is adjourned.

Milly Mount discussed Impact Grants (money that PTA awards to teachers and staff to offset any expenses they may have) Total \$17,125

- \$325 per grade-level teacher, VPreK and STEM
- \$500 per lamps
- \$325 ESL, Apex, and Intervention
- \$500 between counselors

Susan Gyura – Dragon Dash coming up October 5<sup>th</sup>. We take pride in not sending items home for the children to sell – we encourage healthy lifestyles/activities and ask students to earn pledges for a Fun Run: music, victory lap, water lap. Celebrate students running 1 mile and celebrate parents/family/friends donating money to the school. Goal this year is \$35,000. Last year we exceeded our goal and raised over \$43,000.
